

LUSC Player and Parent Contract 2010-11

(*) Represents rules that apply for players AND parents

1. *I will be on time to every scheduled practice or game. If I will be late or am unable to attend, I will give the coach a call at least two hours before the event.
2. *I will control my temper. I will not mouth off to players, referees, coaches, or spectators.
3. I will commit to working as hard as I can every time I step on the soccer field (practice or game).
4. *I will respect every member of this team (parents, players, and coaches). I will treat others how I want to be treated.
5. *I will be generous when my team wins and be gracious in defeat.
6. *I will follow the tournament rules on tournament weekends – for example, diet, curfew, punctuality, and rest.
7. I will come prepared for practice and games (**inflated ball**, shin guards, practice or game uniform, water, etc.).
8. I will show respect to every adult on this team. Players will not at anytime be permitted to disrespect an adult when they are in the presence of this team.

PARENTS:

9. I understand that LUSC has a strict no pay, no play, policy and I will satisfy my players financial obligations to the club AND to my team in a timely fashion. I understand that my players pass may be recalled by the club for non-payment of any financial obligation related to playing for LUSC.
10. I understand that LUSC is dependent on volunteers and commit to fulfilling my volunteer responsibility during the week-end of the Chill Out tournament in the spring.

I WILL NOT:

- *Encourage or employ verbal or physical abuse in the game.
- *Ridicule or yell at any player for making a mistake.
- *Question a coach's or referee's judgment, honesty, or authority.

By signing this contract, I give my word that I will follow these simple rules. If I fail to follow these rules, I understand that there will be consequences.

CONSEQUENCES

Minor offenses will result in extra work at practice or loss of playing time in the game. Anything deemed chronic or major by the coach will result in a meeting with the parents and the player. At this meeting, the player will either be asked to leave the team or will be given one last chance to get with the program.
